Describe Cause of Problem and Remedial Action Taken.*
Rod packing leaked approximately 15 barrels of oil onto the ground. The oil flowed off of the location and down a slope to the west. The oil traveled about 300 yards off of the location. The rod packing has been replaced.

Describe Area Affected and Cleanup Action Taken.*
The soil on the well pad and the impact area were removed and transported to TNT land farm. Approximately twenty 20 yard loads of soil were removed. The area was contoured using soil from a dry pond located approximately 100 yards from the impacted slope. Erosion control weirs were installed per Jicarilla Apache Tribal instructions. The area will be reseeded per Jicarilla Apache Tribal instructions.
