


Describe Cause of Problem and Remedial Action Taken.* Tank drain valve broke due to freeze. 160BBLS of oil was released into secondary containment. Upon discovery the broken tank drain valve was replaced, a vac truck was called to site and recovered 160BBLS of oil and disposed of back into repaired tank. Notified NMOCD District III verbally within 24 hours. Notified BLM Farmington verbally within 24 hours. Will follow up with NMOCD and BLM within 15 days in writing, and will notify EPA within 60 days in writing.

Describe Area Affected and Cleanup Action Taken.* The 160 BBL oil release was all contained within secondary containment. Vac truck was called on site and recovered all 160BBLS of oil and disposed of back into repaired tank.
