Reference is made to your letter dated November 21, 2011 concerning our Trading Post Disp. #1, which is located 950' FNL and 1600' FWL of Sec. 26, T25N and R11W, in San Juan County, NM. This was completed as a lower Dakota water injection well. Under the injection pressure limitations the well remains a very marginal water disposal well. Maralex is actively attempting to purchase uphole mineral rights and would like to recomplate this well.
