Describe Cause of Problem and Remedial Action Taken.\* **On March 3, 2008, a ConocoPhillips Company employee discovered a produced water spill of approximately 40 BBL at the Lewis Park Unit #100S due to a tank overflow. The overflow occurred after the transfer pump froze. The pumping unit was shut down manually.**

Describe Area Affected and Cleanup Action Taken.\* **All of the spilled fluids were contained in the berm, affecting an area of 20' x 20', but none was recovered. A trucking company pulled the berm and tanks on the freeze. A general water quality analysis of the produced water will be performed. The affected soils will be raked when the snow melts.**
