After further internal discussion, this office has rejected the 3160-5 sundry notice dated 1/18/2012 to correct the dedicated acres to the spacing unit. This office will honor the original dedication of the S/2 320 acres of section 24-24N-9W that was submitted with the Application to Permit to Drill on 11/01/2011.
