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## San Juan Coal Company Closed-loop Plans

#### **Closed-looped Design Plan**

San Juan Coal Company's closed-loop system will not entail a drying pad, temporary pit, below grade tank or sump. It will include an above ground tank(s) suitable for holding the cuttings and fluids for rig operations. The tank(s) will be sufficient volume to maintain a safe free board between disposal of the liquids and solids from rig operations.

- 1. Fencing is not required for an above ground closed-loop system
- 2. It will be signed in compliance with 19.15.3.103 NMAC
- 3. A frac tank will be on location to store fresh water

#### Closed-loop Operating and Maintenance Plan

San Juan Coal's closed-loop tank will be operated and maintained to contain liquids and solids in order to prevent contamination of fresh water sources, in order to protect public health and the environment. To ensure the operation is maintained, the following steps will be followed:

- 1. The liquids and solids will be vacuumed out and disposed of at either IEI's disposal facility (Permit Number NM-01-0010B) or Envirotech Soil Remediation's disposal facility (Permit Number: NM-01-0011) on a periodic basis to prevent over topping.
- 2. No hazardous waste, miscellaneous solid waste or debris will be discharged into or stored in the tank(s). Only fluids or cuttings used or generated by rig operations will be placed or stored in the tank.
- 3. The division district office will be notified within 48 hours of the discovery of compromised integrity of the closed-loop tank. Upon the discovery of the compromised tank, repairs will be enacted immediately.
- 4. All of the above operations will be inspected and a log will be signed and dated. During rig operations, the inspection will be daily.

### **Closed-loop Closure Plan**

The closed-loop tank will be closed in accordance with 19.15.17.13. This will be done by transporting cuttings and all remaining sludges to either IEI's disposal facility (Permit Number NM-01-0010B) or Envirotech Soil Remediation's disposal facility (Permit Number: NM-01-0011). The tank(s) will be removed from the location as part of the rig move. The mine owner; San Juan Coal, will reclaim the well site in compliance with the existing Mining & Minerals Division approved Reclamation Plan (copy previously submitted under API #30-045-33326, Kelly FC #1 well, for your review).
