

Describe Cause of Problem and Remedial Action Taken.* **On the morning of 2/21/08, a ConocoPhillips Company MSO (lease operator) discovered a spill of approximately 184 BBL (154 BBL of condensate and 30 BBL of produced water) at the San Juan 28-6 Unit #15A. The valve on the oil tank froze and parted, causing the spill. The fluids saturated the area inside the berm, and none were recovered.**

Describe Area Affected and Cleanup Action Taken.* **The valve on the tank was replaced.**
