This is to report a release of approximately 15 bbls of paraffin from our Riddle B #224 well, located in Unit Letter I, Section 27 – T30N – R10W in San Juan County. All fluids were contain inside a lined berm – so no fluids contacted the soils and all fluids were recovered. The above ground pit tank overflowed when the well produced more fluids than expected following a down hole treatment for paraffin. The release was discovered at 4:30 pm on Monday (11/22/10).
