Plug and Abandonment Report Notified NMOCD and BLM on 3/30/12

Plug and Abandonment Summary:

Plug #1 with 130 sxs (153.4 cf) Class B cement, pump 10-12 sxs, drop 10 RCN balls, then pump remaining 118 sxs down casing 2 bpm at 0#.

Plug #2 with 40 sxs Class B cement fill casing and annulus then install P&A marker.

Plugging Work Details:

4/2/12 MOL with cement equipment. Check well pressures: casing 21 psi, tubing and bradenhead 0 psi. Pump 20 bbls water down casing at 2 bpm at 0 psi. Spot Plug #1. Casing went on a vacuum when well was SI. SDFD.

4/3/12 Open up well; no pressures. RU A-Plus Wireline and tag TOC at 624'. Pressure test casing to 600 psi. B. Powell, NMOCD, required poly-pipe to plug from 200'. Cut off wellhead. RIH with poly pipe to 200'. Spot plug #2 and install P&A marker. RD. MOL.
