Our plan is to drill an infield well to the Pinon #1 (Pinon 35 #44 see attached information) complete and produce both wells hoping to get better draw down on the formation resulting in commercial gas quantities. The Pinon #35 #44 APD has been sent and is waiting on approval from the Farmington BLM office.
