XTO Energy, Inc. requests approval for an exception to NMOCD Rule 303-C to permit DHC of production from the Basin Dakota & Blanco Mesa Verde in the Florance #65M. XTO Energy, Inc. proposes to downhole commingle these pools upon completion of this well.

Allocations are based upon a 9-section EUR and are calculated as follows:

Basin Dakota	Gas 45%	Oil 65%
Blanco Mesa Verde	Gas 55%	Oil 38%

Both pools are included in the New Mexico Oil Conservation Division pre-approved pool combinations for downhole commingling in the San Juan Basin. Working interest, net royalty interest and overriding royalty interest owners have been notified by certified, return receipt mail on April 21st, 2005. The NMOCD has been notified of our intent by submission of a C-103. Downhole commingling will offer an economical method of production while protecting against reservoir damage, waste of reserves & violation of correlative rights.
