This letter is in response to your correspondence dated May 5, 2005, regarding justification of the sundry notices dated April 4, 2005 for temporary abandonment of the following wells:

- 30-039-23342*
- 1) No. 1 Jicarilla 451 located 1650' FSL & 1750' FWL Section 4, T29N, R3W, Rio Arriba, New Mexico)

Black Hills Gas Resources (BHGR) is in the development phase of a geologic model of the various intervals within the Mesaverde/Gallup formations. Since this well is one of few wells in the area that has penetrated these deeper horizons, BHGR has decided to temporarily abandon this well.

- 2) No. 1 Jicarilla 29-03-14 (located 820' FNL & 2005' FEL Section 14, T29N, R3W, Rio Arriba, New Mexico).

BHEP is currently evaluating the potential and economics of deepening this well to test the Pictured Cliffs formation.
