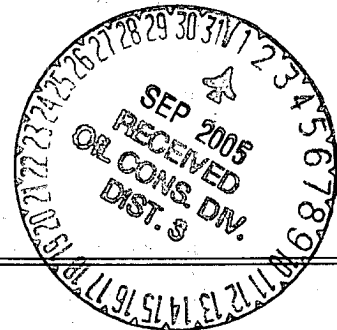

Plug & Abandonment Report

Summary:

Notified BLM & NMOCD 7/28/05

7/28/05 MOL. RU equipment. Dig out bradenhead valve. Well pressures: 60# casing pressure, no tubing. ND wellhead. NU BOP. TIH with 2.875" wireline gauge ring to 3813'. TIH and set 2.875" PlugWell CIBP at 3813'. PU 122 joints A-Plus 1.25" tubing workstring and tag CIBP at 3813'. Shut in well.

7/29/05 Pump 5 bbls water down tubing, plugged. TOH with tubing and found plug 2 joints from bottom. RIH with tubing. Circulate well with 20 bbls of water. Attempt to pressure test casing to 500#, bled down 250# in 1 minute.

Plug #1 with CIBP at 3813', spot 10 sxs Type III cement (13 cf) inside casing from 3813' to 3407' to isolate the Chacra perforations.

PUH and WOC. TIH with tubing and tag cement at 3617'. B. Vigil, BLM, approved tag.

Plug #2 spot 25 sxs Type III cement (33 cf) inside casing from 2998' to 1983' to cover the Pictured Cliffs, Fruitland, Kirtland and Ojo Alamo tops.

TOH with tubing. Shut in well.

8/01/05 TIH and tag cement at 1955'. Load casing with 4 bbls of water. Attempt to pressure test casing, leak 1/4 bpm at 1000#. PUH to 1010'

Plug #3 spot 6 sxs Type III cement (8 cf) inside casing from 1010' to 767' to cover the Nacimiento top.

TOH and LD tubing. WOC. RIH with wireline and tag cement at 730'. Perforate 2 squeeze holes at 184'. Establish circulation out bradenhead with 40 bbls of water.

Plug #4 with 73 sxs Type III cement (97 cf) pumped down the 2.875" casing from 184' to surface, circulate good cement out bradenhead valve.

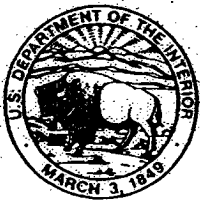
Shut in well and WOC. Dig out and cut off wellhead. Found cement at surface in the 2.875" casing and annulus.

Install P&A marker with 20 sxs Type III cement.

RD rig and equipment. MOL.

Reference is made to your well No. 230 Rincon Unit located 970' FSL & 790' FWL sec. 28, T. 27 N., R. 7 W., Rio Arriba County, New Mexico, Lease NMSF-080213. Also referenced is our letter dated March 31, 2005, which required you to plug and abandon the above mentioned well and to submit a subsequent report of abandonment by April 30, 2005.

You are in violation of 43 CFR 3163.1. This is a minor violation. If the violation is not corrected you may be subject to an assessment. You have until May 31, 2005 to correct this violation. Failure to comply within the time above may result in an assessment in accordance with 43 CFR 3163.1.

Under provisions of 43 CFR 3165.3, you may request an Administrative Review of the orders described above. Such request, including all supporting documents, must be filed in writing within 20 business days of receipt of this notice and must be filed with the State Director, Bureau of Land Management (NM-93000), P. O. Box 27115, Santa Fe, New Mexico 87502-0115. Such requests shall not result in a suspension of the order(s) unless the reviewing official so determines. Procedures governing appeals from instructions, orders or decisions are contained in 43 CFR 3165.4 and 43 CFR 4.400 et seq.
