

**The tank was being gauged when it was discovered no fluid was in the tank. A visual tank and seal inspection was done where a 2" hole on the bottom weld of the tank was discovered releasing 119bbls condensate and 17bbls of produced water. No free standing fluid was in the berm area and no amount of the release was recovered. The well was shut-in and is waiting on repair.**
