
Describe Cause of Problem and Remedial Action Taken.*

Optimizer contacted and informed that private citizen had backed into an above ground valve on location. Field technician arrived shortly thereafter and found piping bent and blowing produced water and natural gas. Well was immediately shut-in.

Describe Area Affected and Cleanup Action Taken.*

Natural gas dissipated to atmosphere so no clean-up action possible. Produced water volume small and raked into soil.
