AN ACTION

RELATING TO NATURAL RESOURCES; APPROVING AN APPLICATION FOR PERMIT TO DRILL AND APPROVING THE GRANTING OF A RIGHT-OF-WAY TO ELM RIDGE RESOURCES, INC. TO DRILL, CONSTRUCT, OPERATE, AND MAINTAIN THE "BISTI COAL 2 2-T" GAS WELL, PIPELINE AND ANCILLARY FACILITIES ON STATE LEASE NO. SL LG-2062 ON, OVER AND ACROSS NAVAJO NATION TRUST LANDS WITHIN THE NAVAJO INDIAN IRRIGATION PROJECT, SAN JUAN COUNTY, NAVAJO NATION (NEW MEXICO)

BE IT ENACTED:

- 1. The Navajo Nation hereby approves an Application for Permit to Drill and approves the granting of a right-of-way to Elm Ridge Resources, Inc. to drill, construct, operate, and maintain the "Bisti Coal 2 2-T" gas well, pipeline and ancillary facilities on State Lease No. SL LG-2062 on, over and across Navajo Nation Trust lands within the Navajo Indian Irrigation Project, San Juan County, Navajo Nation (New Mexico), attached hereto as Exhibits "A" through "F".
- 2. The Navajo Nation hereby approves an Application for Permit to Drill and right-of-way to Elm Ridge Resources, Inc., for a term that shall not exceed 20 years, beginning on the date the Application for Permit to Drill and right-of-way is approved by the Secretary of the Interior, subject to, but not limited to, the terms and conditions contained in Exhibit "D", attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference.
- 3. The Navajo Nation hereby assesses no consideration for the grant of the Permit to Drill and right-of-way in the amount of \$12,526.09, as stated in Exhibit "D". The Navajo Nation hereby assesses compensation in the amount of \$6,265.13 for surface damage, see Exhibit "C".
- 4. The Navajo Nation hereby authorizes the President of the Navajo Nation to execute any and all documents necessary to effectuate the intent and purpose of this resolution.
