
Describe Cause of Problem and Remedial Action Taken.\*

NMOCD inspector noticed gas bubbling through water in the casing that comprises the dry-hole marker for the well. This well is on the east end of the horse barns at McGee Park. BP personnel checked the casing and could hear gas bubbling, but volume was minimal. LEL readings with gas monitor were 10-15 ppm six inches away from the casing and 0 ppm two feet from the casing. BP plans to cut the casing and install a temporary cap to prevent gas leakage the week of May 20th. When horse racing season is over in mid-June arrangements will be made with McGee Park management so work can be done on the well to permanently fix the leak.

Describe Area Affected and Cleanup Action Taken.\*

No area was affected by the release and no clean-up action was necessary.
