

**Rig up truck was transporting frac tank to location when traveling up hill produced fluid released out of the tank in small amounts approximately 10 miles in length.**

**The stained soil was removed and placed in a drum. The third party contractor will transport the contents to an approved disposal facility. Soil sampling was not performed due to the small amount of substance released and subsurface staining being removed. Approval from the NMOCD (Brandon Powell) was received to remove the contents without sampling.**
