During drilling operations, a rig hand on Aztec 950 drilling rig was fueling diesel powered generator sets that supply electricity for trailers. Rig hand left fueling area unattended allowing approximately 15 gallons of diesel fuel to overflow fuel tank and be released to pad surface. Situation was promptly identified, fuel dispensing was halted and release was stopped and contained. Following remediation of pad surface, rig hands were reminded of the necessity of remaining present and attentive during fuel dispensing operations.

Describe Area Affected and Cleanup Action Taken.*

A vacuum truck was dispatched to the spill location to collect any free standing fluids. All impacted soils were collected and properly disposed using hand tools.
