In view of the foregoing, this office has withdrawn this APD. In addition, we will require a letter confirming that no surface disturbing activities have been conducted at this well site. Please file the letter within 30 days of receipt of this notice.

Box 27115, Santa Fe, New Mexico 87502-0115. Such a request will not result in a suspension of the instructions, orders, or decisions unless the reviewing official so determines. Procedures governing appeals from the instructions, orders, or decisions are contained in 43 CFR 3165.4 and 43 CFR 4.400 et. Seq.
