1. MIRU WOR. ND tree. NU BOP.
2. Install 3000 psi BOP.
3. TOOH & LD pkr.
4. TIH to RBP @ 1750' & latch on to RBP. Move RBP and reset @ ±1610'.
5. TIH w/ 2 3/8" tubing. Cir & load hole w/treated water. SI pipe rams & pretest casing to 500 psi for 30 min. Rel pres.
6. ND BOP. NU Valve. RD & Rel all equipment.
7. Contact NMOCD & BLM to witness pressure test. Test to 500 psi/30 min – wellhead/casing and plug.
8. TA Well
