
Describe Cause of Problem and Remedial Action Taken.*

Equipment malfunction allowed water and oil to spill over into production tank causing 13bbbls of hydrocarbon to overflow from the tank onto the soil. The release was contained within the berm. None of the release was recovered and the equipment was shut-in immediately.

ConocoPhillips will assess the soil to determine a path forward for clean-up if necessary.
