Investigations point to oil getting into the fuel gas line on the separator and catching fire when the oil got to the pilot light. The fuel gas line was shut in and a fire extinguisher was used to put the fire out.

Describe Area Affected and Cleanup Action Taken.*

Damage from the fire was limited to the flame arrester on the separator.
