The Horton 4A well was drilled in 1978 by Hallador Petroleum's predecessor, Kimbark Operating Company, and was plugged and abandoned in 1995. County records indicate you are the current surface owners A plat showing surface ownership as well as locations of wells and roads in the area is attached for your reference. The Farmington Field Office, Bureau of Land Management has asked Hallador to file a formal notice to reflect that the well location and access road have been reclaimed along with a letter showing that the landowners, in this case you, concur.

Our inspection of the Horton 4A location indicates the vegetation, appearance, etc. of the former well site is consistent with the surrounding area and a final notice of abandonment can be filed now. However, the access road was originally a dual-purpose road serving both the Horton 4A and the Horton 11. The Horton 11 is still producing; thus the road cannot be reclaimed at this time.




