This is considered removal of produced water from an injection well. The well will not be converted to a water supply well. The volume of water to be removed cannot exceed the total historical volume of produced water injected into this well.

WPX will need to continuously track the volumes of all the produced water removed from this well and have it available upon request.

WPX is required to file a sundry with the total volumes removed within 30 days from the cessation of the water removal.

The SWD order is still in full force and effect including the loss of injection authority for 12 consecutive months of no injection. If the permit expires a complete new application will be required and no injection or removal will be allowed until the permit is approved.

A witnessed MIT will be required prior to injection resuming in this well.

Provide results of any water samples taken during the re-use operation.
