Allocation for the San Juan 29-6 Unit #92M (API 30-039-27555)

The San Juan 29-6 Unit #92M is an 80-acre Mesaverde/160-acre Dakota infill well located in the northwest quarter of Section 12-T29N-R6W, Rio Arriba County, NM. The well was TD'd in November 2004, perforated & fracture stimulated in December 2004, and ready for first delivery on February 14, 2005.

Initial flow tests as reported by the field operator indicated:

Mesaverde (2-3/8" tubing at 5,470', perfs 5,270-5,692' OA, composite plug at 5,750')

1/12/05 1/2" choke N/A* psi tbg. press. 215 psi fcp 1,419 MCFPD + 0 BOPD + 5 BWPD

Dakota (2-3/8" tubing set in retainer at 7,677', perfs 7,707-7,799' OA, PBTD 7,874' Sj MD)

2/07/05 1/2" choke 35 psi ftp 330** psi sicp 231 MCFPD + 0 BOPD + 20 BWPD

Based on these initial stabilized flow tests, calculated DHC allocation percentages are:

Fixed Allocation (Gas)	Mesaverde	86%
	Dakota	14%

Fixed Allocation (Oil)	Mesaverde	100%
	Dakota	0%

No oil was produced during these tests. Based on historical production data from offset wells, the Dakota is very dry and is expected to produce no oil. Therefore 100% of any oil production should be allocated to the Mesaverde.

Please allocate production based on the above estimated percentages.
