Final Report - All "farmed" soil on the abandoned location of Reames Com 1-E (soil was excavated from Romero Com 1) has been removed and placed back in the excavation on Romero Com 1 (API# 30-039-22892). Envirotech, Inc., Farmington, NM (an environmental testing and remediation company) sampled the "farmed" soil (Sep 20, 2005). Test results were submitted to New Mexico Oil Conservation Division (NMOCD) for final review and closure approval. NMOCD approved the pit closure for Romero Com 1, including the movement of the "farmed" soil back to the excavation. Approval was granted by NMOCD on October 11, 2005. CDX Rio, LLC will smooth and disk the abandoned location and then reseed. CDX Rio also wishes to thank the BLM for its understanding and permission to use the location of Reames Com 1-E for soil "farming" activities.
