Blow Pit: overflow pipe halfway between top and bottom and to extend over plastic liner and into blow pit.



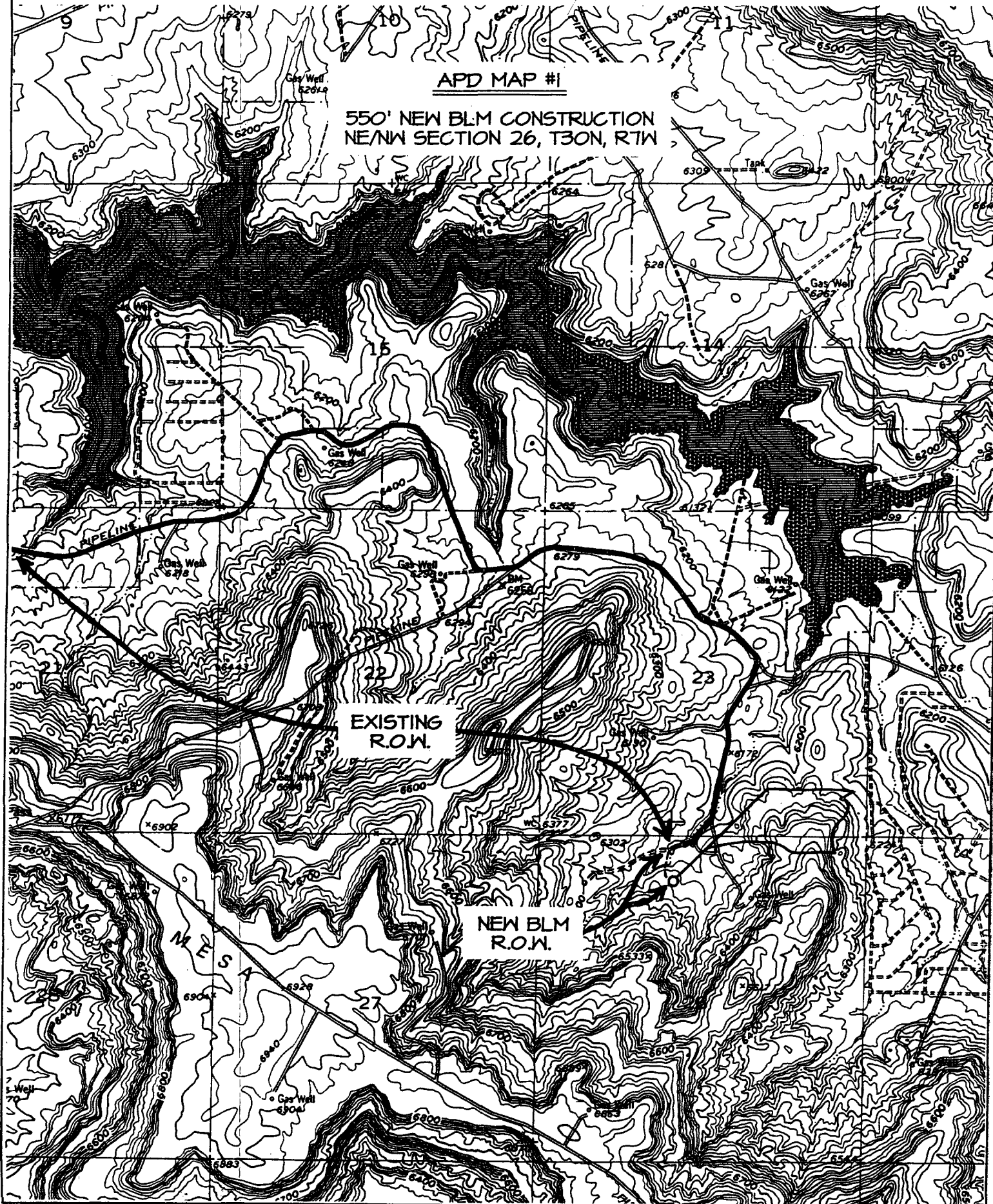

Directions from the Intersection of US Hwy 550 & State Hwy 64 in Bloomfield, NM
to Burlington Resources Oil & Gas Company San Juan 30-6 Unit #95B

750' FNL & 2170' FWL, Section 26, T30N, R7W, N.M.P.M., Rio Arriba County, NM

From the intersection of US Hwy 550 & State Hwy 64 in Bloomfield, NM, travel Easterly on State Hwy 64 for 24.0 miles to State Highway 539;

Go left (North-easterly) on State Highway 539 for 3.9 miles;

Go right (North-easterly) on DeLasso Loos Road for 6.0 miles to fork in road;

Go right (South-westerly) for 0.3 miles to fork in road;

Go left which is straight (South-easterly) for 0.3 miles to fork in road;

Go right (South-westerly) for 0.2 miles to new access on left-hand side of existing roadway which continues for 550' to staked location.
