

Gentleman:

On April 22, 2014 the Farmington Field Office, Bureau of Land Management conducted a field inspection on the Newsome A #16, 1725FSL & 990FWL, Section 10, T26N. R08W, lease number NMSF-078430 to evaluate the success of the final reclamation for this well site. According to our records this well was plugged on August 31, 2010. Conditions of Approval (COA's) attached to the approved Notice of Intent to Abandon required that the well location and access road be reclaimed within one year of the plugging date. We are sending back to you the Sundry Notice requesting a FAN on this well because of the following inspection results:

- 1) Access road embedded and lacks vegetation.
- 2) Non-native gravel left on location.
- 3) Traffic driving on access and location.

Please notify this office after remedial actions have been performed.
