1. Date and Time of occurrence: Between 5pm 1/8/16 and 12:00pm 1/9/16. Discovered release at 12:00pm 1/9/16.
2. Notified Ryan Joyner, Tres Rios BLM via phone call on 1/11/16 at 10:45am.
3. Type of event was an oil spill.
4. Nature and Cause of event: Walsh Engineering discovered a water dump valve on the heater treater stuck open and it caused approximately 70 BBLS of oil to pour into the containment pit and then approximately 130 BBLS of oil overflowed into the lined containment berm. There was no breach of containment and no oil spilled onto the pad area.
5. Environmental Impact: None, containment area was lined and all oil was recovered.
