Vanessa Fields/NMOCD spoke with mechanic on site and took photos. She then contacted Bayless and spoke with Helen Trujillo and advised this needed to be reported since it sprayed off wellsite.


Bayless intends to remove the sprayed soil, then take a 5-point composite soil sample of the area and submit to NMOCD and BLM.
