Hello John,

Thank you for taking time out of your day to discuss the minor access road and well-connect pipeline corridor reroute requirements for Encana's Nageezi Unit 232H and 233H (formerly Lybrook P28-2307) (BLM Lease Nos. NMNM-58878 and 010113/921845). Per our discussion, Encana is proposing to reroute approximately 300 to 400-feet of the northeastern terminus of the access road and well-connect pipeline corridor where they enter the well pad approximately 30 feet south from the original location. Encana **would not** be required to conduct Brack's hardwall cactus (*Sclerocactus cloverae* ssp. *brackii*) surveys on the re-route portions thus eliminating the need to conduct potential Brack's hardwall cactus transplants.

In addition, Encana has already brush hogged the southwestern terminus of the access road and well-connect pipeline corridor up to the reroute section and then walked their equipment onto the well pad to complete brush hogging. Once Encana receives the Sundry from the BLM for the rerouted portion of the project, Encana **would not** be required to conduct Migratory Bird Treaty Act pre-construction nest surveys prior to brush hogging the rerouted portion of the project area.
