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The Application for Permit to Drill (APD) the reference well was received on April 21, 2010 and approved May 03, 2010 for a two year period. A request for an extension of the expiration date was never received by this office. Our records indicate that drilling operations on the above well never commenced prior to the expiration date of May 03, 2012; therefore, this APD has expired. If you decide to drill this location at a later date you will need to submit another application in accordance with Onshore Order Number 1.

Any surface disturbance associated with the approved location of this well must be reclaimed in accordance with the Surface Use Plan of Operations in the approved APD and to the satisfaction of the Bureau of Indian Affairs. Please contact Ryan Joyner at 970-385-1242 in order to schedule an onsite meeting for the discussion of reclamation requirements. Once any reclamation work has been completed and the site is ready for inspection, a final abandonment notice (Form 3160-5) will need to be submitted to the BLM for approval.
