**Well:** Apache # 154, UL O Sec. 3 Twn. 24N Rge. 4W, API # 30-039-23886

Dear Mr. Tovias:

The 2018 Bradenhead test on the above well indicates a failure. In order to comply with Rule 19.15.16.11, prevent waste and protect fresh water, you are hereby directed to submit a plan of action before **June 20, 2019**, and to initiate remedial activity before **August 20, 2019**. At time of test: Initial Surface Casing psi was 12. Initial Production Casing psi was 135. Five-minute shut-in pressure on Surface Casing was 0. However, the bradenhead pressures back to 100 lbs.

Samples were taken from production casing and bradenhead prior to testing on May 6, 2017. Analysis have not been received.

Enervest Operating LLC is directed to find source of gas and fix within 90 days of the date of this letter.
