Elm Ridge Exploration Co. LLC had a rig on location from March 3 through March 8, 2006, to replace bad tubing, hot oil, and clean out to PBTD. At this point in time, the well is still incapable of production. It appears that an early screenout during the initial fracture stimulation has prevented this well from producing. It is our intention to refrac this well within the next 120 days, depending upon rig and frac crew availability.
