
Because of recent safety problems with the gas tap to your home, it has been determined that for safety reasons, and the potential liability to XTO Energy Inc., the gas tap must be terminated.

XTO will pay for the cost of substituting propane service to your home, and the cost of converting your appliances to use propane. With spring coming on and warmer days, we would like to set up a time next week, March 13<sup>th</sup> -17<sup>th</sup> to have a plumber come out and look at your appliances to see how much will be involved in the conversion. This should be a smooth transition and shouldn't take more than one day to complete.

Enclosed please find a Gas Tap Release/Propane Use Agreement and a Waiver of Right to Use Gas for your review. These documents will require your signature before we change the gas tap over to propane.

XTO will pay for the rental of the propane tank, and the propane supplier will send its invoices to XTO at its local address, 2700 Farmington Avenue, Building K, Suite 1, Farmington, New Mexico 87401.
