
Mr Perrin:

The purpose of this letter is to settle the final disposition of the above mentioned Ute #1(F) well. This well has appeared on several idle well reports over the years and with this letter the BLM hopes to put this matter to rest. This well has resulted in some confusion due to its age and that we do not have a wellfile on it. PI/Dwights shows this well ( 1 Barker Dome) was drilled in 1960 and the well was put into production

On January 18, 2006 an inspector from this office went to the legal location of this well to determine the status of this well. The inspector found the well to be permanently plugged and abandoned. A dry hole marker was present at the location. Four Photos of the dry hole marker have been emailed to your office on May 31, 2006.
