On April 29 2003, Chuck Smith from Burlington Resources requested that the Burlington proposed well, Prichard Federal 1M, be approved for drilling. This well is located near a historic golden eagle nest (# 84), and a stipulation was placed on the well that no drilling, completion, or other construction activities could take place between March 1 and June 30 due to nesting golden eagles. FFO contracts with Hawks Aloft to conduct golden eagle nest surveys annually to determine nesting activity. Hawks Aloft checked nest 84 on March 13, and found a female on the nest. Hawks Aloft again checked the nest on April 25, and found no birds on the nest or in the area and reported to FFO a probable nest failure. After Mr. Smith requested the release of the Prichard Federal 1M, FFO again checked the nest on April 30 and confirmed that there was no activity at nest 84. Barney Wegener designated the nest not active on April 30 and informed Chuck Smith that Burlington could proceed with the proposed well in the spring of 2003. However, the timing stipulation of no drilling, completion, or other construction activities from March 1 to June 30 will apply to activities on the Prichard Federal 1M in future years.
