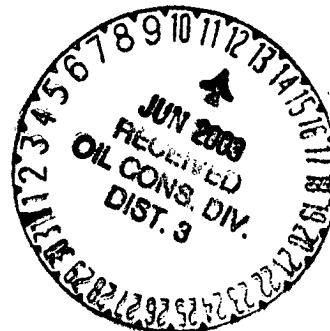

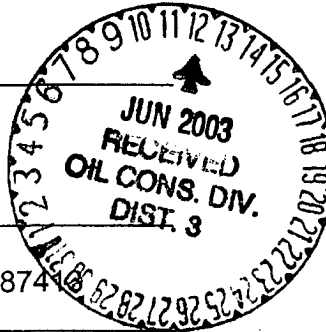

13. Describe Proposed or Completed Operations

A-Plus Well Service Plugged and Abandoned the above well under an emergency procurement to NMSA 1978, Section 13-1-127. Contract Number: 03-521-0700-0200.

4-29-03: MOL & RU. Pressure test tubing to 500#, OK. POH and LD 41 5/8" rods with pump.

4-30-03: NU BOP. TOH with 35 joints 2-3/8" tubing, total 1,134'. Set 4-1/2" PlugWell CIBP at 1050'. TIH with tubing. Circulate well clean. Pressure test casing to 500#, held OK. Plug #1 with CIBP at 1050', spot 23 sxs cement inside casing above CIBP up to 753'. TOH and LD tubing. Perforate 3 squeeze holes at 141'. Establish circulation out BH. Plug #2 with 51 sxs cement pumped down the casing from 141' to surface, circulate good cement out bradenhead. Cut off wellhead. Mix 19 sxs cement and install P&A marker. MOL.
