Reference is made to the following Application for Permit to Drill (APD):

Cox Canyon #9C, located 1980' FNL and 1905' FWL, Section 20, T32N, R11W, San Juan County, New Mexico on federal lease No. NMNM 010910, API No. 30-045-31238

This APD was approved on February 14, 2003 with an expiration date of February 15, 2006. This APD has been extended twice, with no action taken. Since this APD is nearly three years old, the cultural and environmental conditions will have to be reevaluated, therefore, a new APD will be required if this well is intended to be drilled in the future. We have already received your resubmission of this APD and have processed and approved it. A new API number will be assigned to the resubmitted APD by the NMOCD.
