- 3) MIRU WL. TIH & set CIBP @ 1,880' (csg collars @ 1,855' & 1,895'). RDMO WL.
- 4) Load casing w/22 BFW. Pressure test casing and CIBP to 500 psig for 30 minutes. Record test on a chart recorder w/a maximum 2 hr clock & 1,000 psig spring, per NMOCD requirements.
- 5) Blow down well. ND BOP. NU WH. RDMO PU.
