#### **SYNOPSIS:**

On 8-15-2006 at approximately 0900 hours, Greg Vigil, Lead Pumper for the Patina Oil and Gas Corporation discovered 148.6 barrels of oil was stolen from a storage tank approximately 2.9 miles East of highway NM 537 milepost 28.3, South of Dulce, N.M. within the boundary of the Jicarilla Apache reservation.

### **INVESTIGATION:**

On 8-16-2006 at approximately 1403 hours, I arrived at the location where the oil was stolen. This was in rough terrain in a remote area 2.9 miles East of highway NM 537 from milepost 28.3. The well site # Tribal 05 #1.

I made contact with Greg Vigil. He is employed with the Patina-Nobele Energy Oil and Gas Corporation, as a Lead Pumper. Vigil stated that the well and equipment belong to the Patina Corps. The Jicarilla Apache Tribe collects royalties from the gas and oil. He states that this Oil well site collects Gas and Oil, and collects water, but are all separated into separate storage areas. He stated he checked the Oil tank on July 30, 2006. There were 11.6 heights of oil in the tank. On August 15, 2006 at 9:00 am, he checked the tank and discovered there were only 4.1 heights in the tank. He states that 7.5 heights of oil are missing from the tank. This adds up to 148.6 barrels of oil which equals approximately \$10,402.00 dollars. Calculated by \$70.00 dollars a barrel.

Mr. Vigil has checked with the dispatcher at the Giant Refinery in Bloomfield, N.M. (505) 632-8024. He asked if the company had pumped the oil from the tank at that well site. They did not have any record that oil was pumped from that well. Vigil stated that their Corps. Will call Giant to pump oil from Oil Wells, then Giant will perform the work. There was no such request made.

Mr. Vigil states there are indications that the Oil was more than likely stolen. The seal from the oil pump spout was missing. It was not recovered on site. He stated that there were big truck tire tracks which were much more visible yesterday. It appeared the truck drove up beside the fence. There was an imprint of the hose, where the hose was laid under the fence. It takes approximately 30-45 minutes to pump the missing oil from the tank. He states the suspect (s) knew what they were doing. They probably had to use a truck with a barrel load capacity of 80 barrels.

Mr. Vigil states this is the first time, he knows of that oil has been stolen from any of their well sites.

After contact with Vigil, I photographed the area, and the well site, and tank that the oil was stolen from. The tank # is G1-10734.
