- cement plug #1 was 14 sxs from 2440 - 2238 ft.
- cement plug #2 was 36 sxs from 964 - 443 ft.
- the casing was perforated @ 254'
- 90 sxs was pumped from the surface through the perforations @ 254', up the backside, and good cement was circulated to the surface
- a P&A marker was installed
