The San Juan Basin Terrestrial Sequestration Pilot. Sandia is field testing their RO water treatment equipment on a COPC wellsite, the 32-8 237A, with produced water. COPC is providing additional tanks, a water supply line, a pad for Sandia's equipment, generator, and other miscellaneous equipment to facilitate the test.

Sandia's equipment will arrive on location May 30th. The test is planned to begin June 18th and run about 60 days contingent upon weather. At the conclusion of the test COPC will remove the equipment associated with the Sandia project and re-claim/re-seed as required.

See the attached well pad diagram that shows the layout of the project (note the entire project is within the existing well pad and original construction zone).
