Dear Mr. Vickery:

We have received two copies of Federal "Application for Permit to Drill" for a well designated as the Carracas Mesa Unit #1-26. The Commission's present policy is not to accept well numbers which include as part of the number the section upon which the well is located. This rule was necessary because of problems arising in our machine accounting section in Santa Fe. With your approval I would, therefore, like to delete the number "26" from the well number, making the well the Carracas Mesa Unit #1. All future wells drilled on this unit should then be numbered consecutively 2-3-4-5, etc.

We also note that Form C-102 submitted with this notice does not identify the acreage to be dedicated to the well, nor are the questions regarding ownership answered, nor is the form signed by an operator's representative. We are, therefore, mailing back to you our copies of the Plat in order that these forms may be completed.

If you do not agree with our well numbering suggestions, please let us know.
