New Drill, Lined:

ConocoPhillips proposes to construct a new drilling pit, an associated vent/flame pit and a pre-set mud pit (if required). Based on a site visit and information attained from the New Mexico Office of the State Engineer, the reported distance from nearest fresh water well has changed from <50' to >200<1000'. ConocoPhillips will construct the pits no deeper than 10' in order to protect groundwater. A portion of the vent/flame pit will be designed to manage fluids and that portion will be lined as per the risk ranking criteria. ConocoPhillips anticipates closing these pits according to the November 1, 2004 Guidelines.
