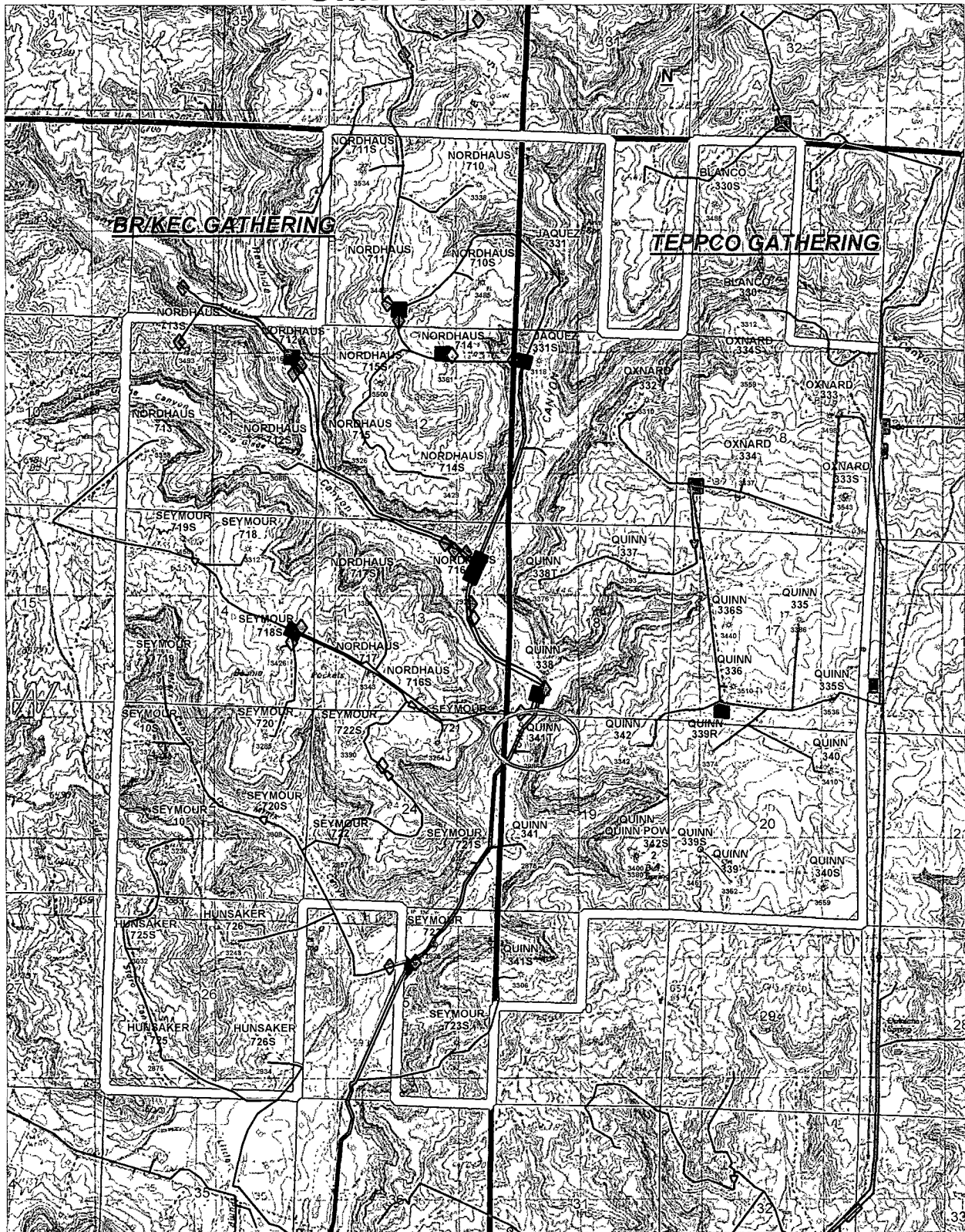

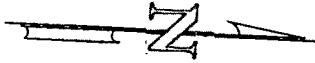

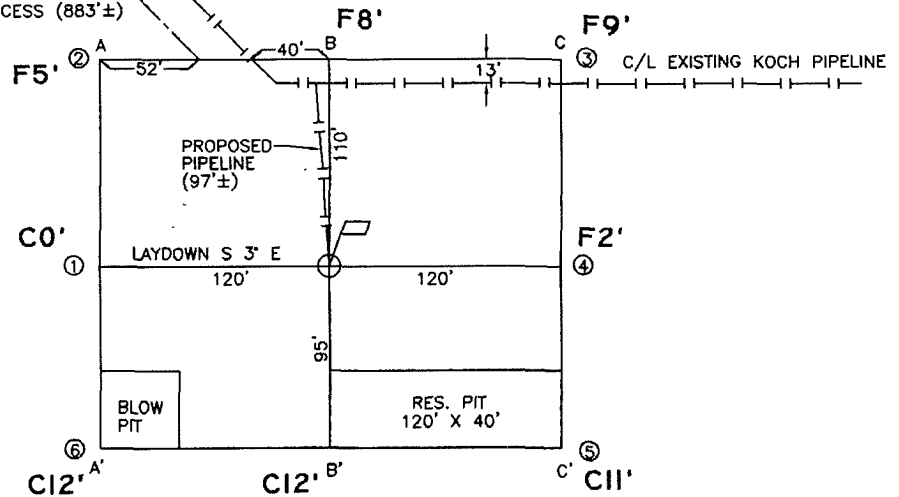

LINE LOCATION!



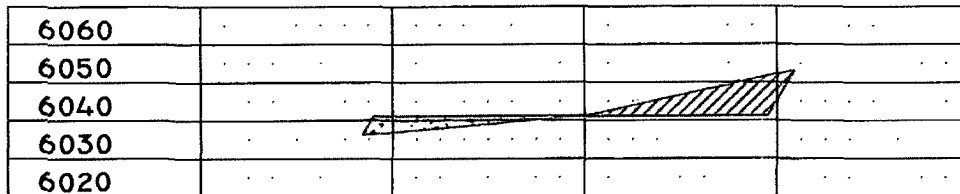

ACCESS (883'±)



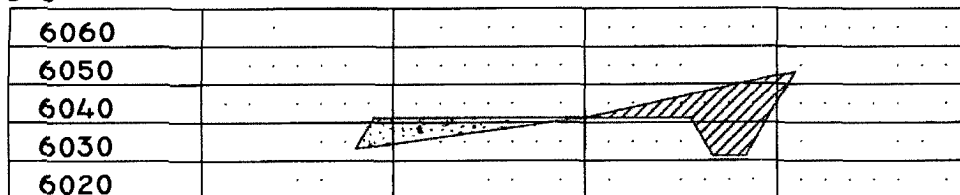

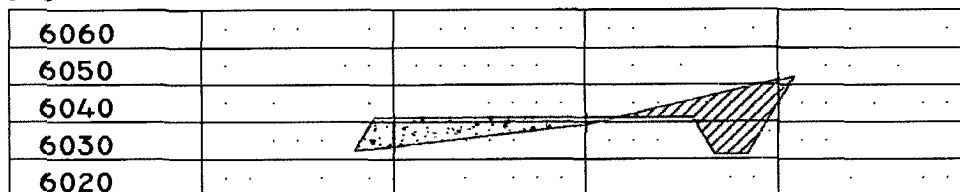
