1. Case #12346, Order #R-11363 establishes the two subject pools as pre-approved for commingling.
2. The pools to be commingled are the Basin Fruitland Coal (71629) and the Fulcher Kutz Pictured Cliffs (77200).
3. The well is presently completed in both pools and is presently awaiting a pipeline connection.
4. Completed intervals are as follows:
 - Pictured Cliffs: 1103'-1117' (15' net pay)
 - Basin Fruitland Coal: 1061'-1067' (8' net pay)
 - 1002'-1006' & 987'-997' (14' net pay)
5. McElvain intends to allocate production based on net pay footage.



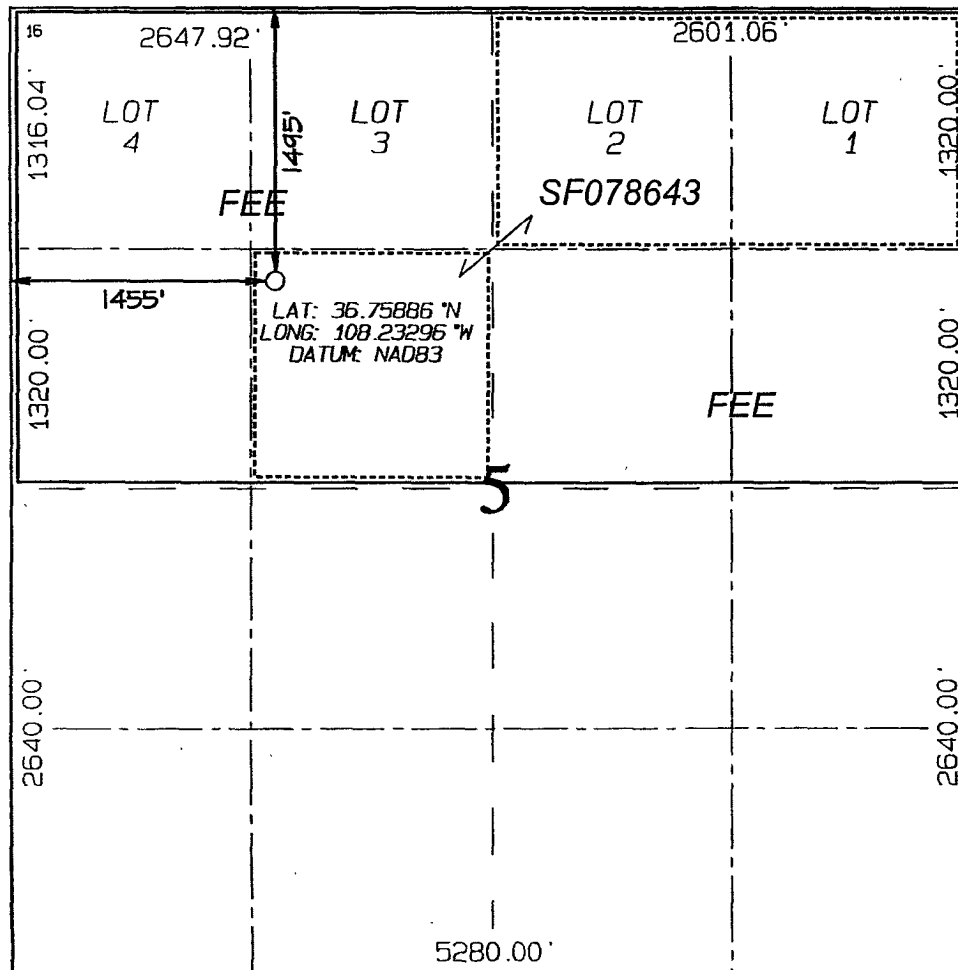

In accordance with the New Mexico Oil Conservation Division Rule 303.C. governing downhole commingling, you are hereby notified that T. H. McElvain Oil & Gas Properties, Inc., as Operator of the above-captioned wells, intends to downhole commingle production from the Basin Fruitland Coal (71629) and the Fulcher Kutz Pictured Cliffs (77200) pools for said wells. These pools are pre-approved for commingling by the State of New Mexico Oil Conservation Division ("NMOCD") of the Energy, Minerals and Natural Resources Department.

The proposed allocation percentages for each pool are as follows.

McElvain intends to allocate production based on net pay footage for the Wildwood #1 well:

Pictured Cliffs: 28%

Fruitland Coal: 72%

McElvain intends to allocate production based on net pay footage for the Wildwood #3 well:

Pictured Cliffs: 41%

Fruitland Coal: 59%

The NMOCD requires all interest owners that may be affected by this proposal be notified of the intent to downhole commingle if ownership is different between zones. Should you have any objection to this application, objections must be filed in writing within twenty days (20) from the date of this letter at the Division office: 1220 So. St. Francis Drive, Santa Fe, New Mexico 87505. If no objection is received within this twenty (20) day period, this application for commingling may be approved.
