In response to your letter of March 5, 2008 (copy attached), Four Star Oil & Gas Co. respectfully requests your approval for a 12 month extension (or until March, 2009) to the current Temporarily Abandoned Status of this well.

Increased development activity from new drill completions and good existing well re-completions has restrained workover rig scheduling and availability. This, along with recent abnormally longer periods of inclement weather and bad road conditions, continues to delay our desires to pursue restoring this well's production viability.

Four Star Oil & Gas Co. plans to develop, submit, and execute an approved workover procedure to return this well back to producing status within the next 12 months. If this proves unsuccessful, then to submit, for approval, a procedure to permanently Plug and Abandon this well.

Your approval of this Request for 1 Year Extension of TA Status will allow us time to safely and properly execute our plans of extending the productive life of this well.

Reference is made to the following wells in New Mexico:

- 1) No. 1 Marshall A, 840' FNL & 830' FEL sec. 14, T. 27 N., R. 9 W., San Juan County, lease NMSF-078357.
- 2) No. 7 CW Roberts, 1650' FSL & 1650' FEL sec. 17, T. 25 N., R. 3 W., Rio Arriba County, lease NMSF-079600.
- 3) No. 8 CW Roberts, 1785' FNL & 1090' FWL sec. 17, T. 25 N., R. 3 W., Rio Arriba County, lease NMSF-079600.

The subject wells were approved for temporary abandonment until March 1, 2008 to evaluate. To date we have not received your plans for the above-mentioned wells.

You have 30 days to comply with this order. The 30 days commences upon receipt of this letter or seven days from the date it is mailed, whichever is less. Failure to comply within the 30 days may result in an assessment in accordance with 43 CFR 3163.1.

Under provisions of 43 CFR 3165.3, you may request an Administrative Review of the orders described above. Such request, including all supporting documents, must be filed in writing within 20 business days of receipt of this notice and must be filed with the State Director, Bureau of Land Management (NM-93000), P. O. Box 27115, Santa Fe, New Mexico 87502-0115. Such requests shall not result in a suspension of the order(s) unless the reviewing official so determines. Procedures governing appeals from instructions, orders or decisions are contained in 43 CFR 3165.4 and 43 CFR 4.400 et seq.
