DETAILS OF WORK

Spudded 9" hole 4/17/59. Set 7" casing at 43' w/7 corks cement. Drilled w/air to 936' & mudded up. Drilled to 23 of 1027'. Ran elec. logs. Set 4" casing at 1025' w/70 corks 15' collar cement. Runged plug down w/200 gals. MCA & oil. Ran Gamma Ray & Collar logs. Perforated from 975' to 990' w/2 jet chisels per foot. Sand/Oil flow w/20,000 gals. lvs. crude and 30,000 sand. Ave. inj. rate 17.5 bbls./min. at 1200'. Cleaned sand from 1022' to 1023' (800). Set 2" tubing at 985'. Ran pump & rods & installed pumping unit. On final 24 hour test on 4-30' 371 gpm at 56 bbls. 1/2. GOR 71, Corr. Cr. 39.2. First new oil to tanks 5/13/59.
